The Public Hearing on the proposed straight leaseback transaction by the Finger Lakes Economic Development Center on behalf of BWF Holdings was held in the Village of Dundee, Dundee Area Youth Center, 15 Main Street in the Village of Dundee, Yates County, New York on Thursday, May 5, 2011 at 2:00 pm.

The Public Hearing notice was published in the legal section of The Chronicle Express on April 20, 2011. The Notice of Public Hearing was also posted on the bulletin board of the Yates County Courthouse on April 20, 2011 and the Village of Dundee on April 25, 2011 and copies of the Notice were mailed to the affected taxing jurisdictions (Yates County, Town of Starkey, Village of Dundee, Dundee Central School District, Yates County Director Real Property Tax Director and Town of Starkey Assessor) on April 18, 2011.

Ryan Hallings, Vice President of Community Development for the Finger Lakes Economic Development Center, called the Public Hearing to order at 2:03 p.m.

Mr. Hallings gave an overview of the BWF Holdings project.

George Lawson would like to encourage the project to utilize local contractors. Question of where the wine industry would be in 10-15 years from now.

Gwen Chamberlain inquired in to the difference of the Cluster of Pines project and the BWF Holdings project. Ms. Chamberlain also had questions regarding the safety of the corner of Route 14 and Dundee Glenora Road where the project will be located due to the increase in traffic.

There being no other comments the Public Hearing was closed at 2:35 p.m. by Mr. Hallings.
